PATHWAYS TO LICENSURE

Our Graduate Programs in Education at MCLA provide you with a clear pathway to complete your Initial Teaching License and your Master's of Education (M.Ed.).

About the Pathway:

- Apply by April 1, July 1 or December 1 to begin the program the following Summer, Fall or Spring.
- All coursework can be completed online and synchronous classes.
- All courses are scheduled in the afternoons, evenings or weekends to meet the needs of working educators.
- Complete your graduate level licensure coursework in 18-24 months.
- Take prep workshops to prepare you for the Massachusetts Tests for Educator Licensure (MTEL).
- Map your program during individual advising sessions with faculty advisors.
